Beginning, Intermediate and Advanced students will explore a variety of techniques used in the construction and decoration of wheel-thrown and hand-built clay objects. The experienced potter and sculptor will be encouraged to investigate different firing, glazing, and finishing techniques in their own work. This includes stoneware and porcelain, low fire surfaces, and Raku; the traditional Japanese technique that allows the artist to be closely involved with the firing process. Beginners and high school students are welcome! The fundamentals of hand building & wheel throwing techniques will be covered in the both sessions. The class fee includes 15lbs of clay, glazes, and firing. All levels welcome.

In this open media studio, beginning and advanced students will have the opportunity to develop compositions of personal themes in the materials of their choice. Students may express their ideas in drawing, painting, 2-D collage or 3-D assemblage. Collage is described as fastening (gluing, sewing, nailing) different scraps of paper, theater tickets, photographs, etc. to a flat surface. The collection of images and textures can then be drawn or painted upon. Assemblage compositions are 3 dimensional, like collage but in relief. Students may bring twigs, pieces of wood, metal, small household objects, etc. to work with. Some basic materials will be provided. Painting students will need to bring acrylic paint in white, red, yellow, blue, and burnt umber, a 1/2" flat bristle and a #5 round bristle brush, and a canvas, canvas board, or scrap of wood to paint on. Ideas, personal directions and introductory projects will be considered and discussed on the first day of class. Just bring what you have and make some art! 1 to 7 weeks open enrollment. Students may sign up for as many classes as they can attend.
