Each week children will get to dig through recycled, reused, vintage and donated goods to create with. Sometimes what is considered junk to some is a treasure for others. We will take a brief walk through the park and near the RAC to clean it and use anything we find that can be used for art.

Over the weekend before class, children are encouraged to search for old items they'd like to bring with to class and/or donations of old goods from home, the outdoors or garage sales. The goal is to help children gain an understanding of the importance of recycling and caring for our community and to see that art is what you make it. Transforming junk from our trunks, basements or sidewalk is a smart way to develop unique works of art and put unloved items to good use.

In this open media studio, beginning and advanced students will have the opportunity to develop compositions of personal themes in the materials of their choice. Students may express their ideas in drawing, painting, 2-D collage or 3-D assemblage. Collage is described as fastening (gluing, sewing, nailing) different scraps of paper, theater tickets, photographs, etc. to a flat surface. The collection of images and textures can then be drawn or painted upon. Assemblage compositions are 3 dimensional, like collage but in relief. Students may bring twigs, pieces of wood, metal, small household objects, etc. to work with. Some basic materials will be provided. Painting students will need to bring acrylic paint in white, red, yellow, blue, and burnt umber, a 1/2" flat bristle and a #5 round bristle brush, and a canvas, canvas board, or scrap of wood to paint on. Ideas, personal directions and introductory projects will be considered and discussed on the first day of class. Just bring what you have and make some art! 1 to 10 weeks open enrollment. Students may sign up for as many classes as they can attend.
